PE & Sport Premium funding proposed spending academic year 2018-19

The PE and sport premium is an element of school funding designed to help primary schools improve the quality of the PE and sport activities they offer their pupils, and encourage the development of healthy and active lifestyles. It must be used for this purpose but as a school we are free to choose the best way of using this money. Schools receive PE and sport premium funding based on the number of pupils in years 1 to 6.

In 2018/19 our PE & Sport Premium funding is anticipated to be £16,700, and below is a summary of the way we propose to use this funding.

- To improve the provision of PE through raised teacher confidence and equipping them with more effective and specialised skills & equipment in certain sporting activities
- To buy a new PE Curriculum to develop teachers knowledge and skill to deliver quality PE
- To buy into the Rushcliffe School Partnership for organised events
- To covers costs of supply cover for PE Coordinator to attend meetings and sporting events enabling more pupils to attend events
- To support disadvantage pupils to access sporting activities
- To deliver Forest Schools to EYFS pupils
- To provide the opportunities for children to participate in sports/activities they wouldn't normally access
- To audit and replace PE equipment
- To purchase of additional PE/Sports resources to support the development of the subject
- To purchase specific equipment to set up a school netball team
- To purchase some play equipment for the playground to encourage more active playtimes and develop the role of play leaders
- To allow the children to experience sports based activities in a residential setting
- To support provision of before and lunchtime school sports clubs
- To develop active, positive playtimes and lunchtimes for our children
- To encourage children to develop healthy lifestyles
